1) What are the signs of hard water?

Buildup on plumbing fixtures, trouble working up a lather in the shower, spotty dishes, and dry skin/hair are some of the key indicators of hard water

2) Is hard water bad for your pipes?

Yes, over time, mineral deposits from hard water can clog certain types of pipes. This can impact flow rates and cause problems with plumbing and appliances

3) How long does it take for hard water to damage appliances?

The timeline depends on the level of water hardness, though studies have shown that hard water can negatively impact fixtures and appliances in as few as seven days. In the short term, hard water can lower the efficiency of water-using appliances and over time, reduce their lifespan.

4) Is hard water bad for your hair?

Yes. Dry, dull hair from mineral buildup is the most common issue, but hard water also can decrease the strength of hair and as a result, lead to more breakage.

5) Is hard water good for the skin?

No. Hard water can leave your skin feeling dry and irritated. It also can exacerbate the symptoms of conditions like eczema.

6) Is soft or hard water better?

Because hard water can cause problems for plumbing and appliances as well as your hair and skin, soft water is typically preferable vs. hard water.

7) How do I reduce water hardness in my home?

By installing a water softener in your house to remove hardness minerals in your water, you can get rid of hard water and its related problems.

8) How do I know if my area has hard water?

Whether you have a well or municipal water, working with a local water expert to test the hardness level of your water is the best way to know for sure.

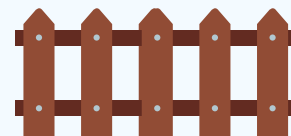

Why It's Important to Add Salt to Your Water Softener on Time

Refilling your brine tank in a timely fashion is one of the most important things you can do to keep your water softener functioning properly. Experts recommend that home water softener users should check their brine tank at least once a month. If the tank appears to be less than half-full, it may be a good idea to add some more salt, but be careful to not overfill the tank. Keep in mind that older softeners may regenerate more frequently, while newer models sometimes include brine tank monitors and regenerate more efficiently based on demand. Adding more salt to your water softener's brine tank as needed allows the regeneration process to proceed effectively.

Maintaining a routine allows you to:

- Avoid water hardness issues
- Observe your water softener for maintenance needs
- Adhering to a regular and timely schedule for refilling your water softener's brine tank also gives you the opportunity to conduct maintenance checks on the appliance.
- As you inspect your brine tank, be on the lookout for signs of *salt bridging and mushing*.
 - **Bridging:** This condition is most likely to happen with solar salt. It occurs when salt in the brine tank cakes or otherwise adheres into a large mass. It may look like your brine tank is full, when in fact, a salt bridge is covering up an empty space. When this happens, your brine solution will not achieve the proper salt concentration for effective regeneration.
 - **Mushing:** This issue is more likely to occur with pellet salt. Similar to bridging, mushing can cause clogs at the bottom of the brine tank. Likewise, this problem will lead to poor regeneration, resulting in hard water exiting the softener.

Monitoring for these issues as you replenish your brine tank's salt supply on a regular basis can help keep your water soft.
