How to Choose the Best Home Reverse Osmosis System

Considering investing in a reverse osmosis drinking water system? We have 5-steps to help you choose the right RO system for you.

1) Your Drinking Water Quality

The first hurdle is knowing what is in your water. Starting with a water test can help you discover whether or not your water has impurities.*

2) Understanding Water Filtration

If you are concerned about chlorine in your water then a water filter pitcher or fridge filter may be enough to tackle your water concerns. However, for other impurities in your water, you may want to consider a RO system. RO's work by pushing water through a membrane that catches the contaminants. More sophisticated systems use that process plus various other stages to provide you with better, cleaner water.

3) Considering Features

With today's technological advances, you may consider a "smart" system that allows you track water consumption along with the lifespan of the filters by using an app. Another feature you may want to think about is the faucet designs and options; everything from the patina to filter-life insights. Or, with some systems you have a choice for faucet-free which allows you access to your RO water with a push of a button.

Water Softener Full of Water? Here's how to fix it

Checking the salt levels in the brine tank is an important part of maintaining your water softener. However, finding that your brine tank is full of water may be a bit concerning. Especially if you've started noticing your old water problems are resurfacing; noticing issues such as soap spots, mineral build-up, or reduced water flow, to name a few.

Prior calling out the professionals to check out your system, listed below are the steps you can take to see if you are able to fix it yourself.

1) Know what you're looking at

The brine/salt tank has a removable lid and is the bigger of the two tanks. When the system is working as it should, the water normally fills between a fourth and half-way up; the salt level is typically higher and the water in the tank isn't visible.

To ensure everything is working properly, start by doing a manual regeneration. After a few minutes, the water in the tank should go down. If the water level remains the same this could suggest a larger issue with the system and a water expert's assistance may be needed.

2) Check for simple problems

Water pressure-all water softeners require a certain amount of pressure to work properly; if it's too low, the system may not be able to regenerate correctly.

Brine line- this line connects the brine tank to the resin tank; if this line isn't attached properly, it can affect the equipment's performance to carry the brine from the brine tank.

Salt bridging- this occurs when the system cannot correctly dissolve the salt; salt pellets get mushy in the bottom of your system, or when solar salt/salt crystals begin to clump together, creating a large crystal.

3) Move on to bigger possibilities

If you aren't experiencing any of the above mentioned issues, it may be time to call an expert. Here are some other possible causes for extra water in your brine tank:

Drain line issues- sometimes the excess water can be caused by a damaged or blocked drain line and needs to be repaired or replaced.

Injector malfunction- if your system doesn't seem to be using salt, this could be due to a clogged injector and requires an expert to repair.

Electronic problems- if you have noticed your system's display screen is showing an incorrect date or time, this due to an electronic malfunction and calls for an expert to resolve the issue.

4) Get help

If your troubleshooting has left you with finding a major issue or with no answers at all, it's time to call your local water expert. They are trained and able to analyze and determine the issue and make any necessary repairs, without damaging your system.

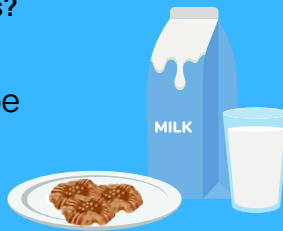
Need a quick/easy recipe for unexpected guests?
