## Is Well Water Hard or Soft

Is well water hard or soft? That's a question that many people share. Generally, hard water\* is found in wells, however, water quality can vary from home to home.

Hard water is created when water travels through rocks and soil, picking up calcium and magnesium particles, to get to the well. Granted our bodies naturally need certain amounts of these elements, they become problematic once they enter your home. These minerals can be "sticky" and attach themselves to your faucets, shower doors, dishes, and even in less obvious places like your plumbing or any of your water-using appliances can be affected.

### Can You Drink Hard Water?

Yes, in general, hard water does not pose as a health concern. Hard water is more so an issue when bathing or washing because hard water doesn't allow soaps to lather to their full potential; it can also become a problem with your hair, skin, and nails.

### Is All Well Water Hard?

Depending on your surroundings, and how the water travels to a well, hardness in water differs from each well.

### Can City Water Be Hard?

The quick answer is "yes". Sometimes city water is collected from similar groundwater sources that could have potentially picked up calcium and magnesium.

Unfortunately, calcium nor magnesium are visible, nor do they have an odor. So you may be wondering how you can tell if your well water is hard? Overtime, your home may start showing signs of hard water; a chalky build-up on sinks, fixtures, and shower doors, to name a few. One downside to being on a well is you are solely responsible for your water quality. Therefore it is recommended to have your well water tested annually due to water tables shifting over time.

If your home is showing signs of hard water, take the guesswork out of testing your water. Culligan's free basic water test can not only assess the hardness of your water, but also determine if there is iron or total dissolved solids (TDS) present, which are common issues in well water.
